

QUESTIONNAIRE ABOUT CONTENT AREA/CERTIFICATIONS

As stated in the catalog, you are required to show evidence that you completed 30 semester credit hours in a content area to teach at the secondary level. Secondary academic subjects include English, mathematics, biology, chemistry, earth science, physics and social studies. For social studies, coursework includes economics and government, and at least 21 semester hours in the history and geography of the United States and world.

Students who do not have the required number of hours must complete the additional credits before applying for New York State initial certification. The additional credits can be earned during the time students are in the MSSE program. In other words, you can still apply for admission if you do not have the required 30 semester credits in the content area you wish to become certified to teach.
