Charge:

The award for outstanding undergraduate scholarship was been established to recognize excellence in academic achievement by undergraduate students. At NTID, ASL-English Interpretation students are eligible. Those selected to receive the award are designated RIT Scholars and the achievement is recognized through an especially designed award emblematic of high academic attainment.

The Outstanding Undergraduate Committee has central responsibility for:

- a) Developing a process to solicit candidates from each department (school) and from individual members of the faculty of the college;
- b) confirming eligibility of potential awardees through the Registrar’s Office;
- c) inviting a member from outside the college to the committee membership;
- d) determining criteria of selection in addition to the minimum Institute requirements specified in the policy statement; and
- e) submitting to Susan Provenzano, Academic Affairs a list of students to receive the award.
