

## ACADEMIC CONDUCT COMMITTEE AY11-12

### Charge:

The NTID Academic Conduct Committee exists under RIT policy to help students and faculty maintain high standards in academic behavior. The Academic Conduct process encourages students and faculty members to resolve their issues prior to formal ACC involvement. In most cases, this is successful. When an issue is brought before the Academic Conduct Committee, the student and faculty member provide supporting data, a decision is made, and a recommendation is made to the VP/Dean of NTID. At the end of the academic year, the committee reports to the NTID faculty the number and kind of cases heard during the preceding year. During Spring quarter, new faculty representatives are elected to serve staggering three-year terms. Student members are elected at the beginning of each academic year for a one-year (renewal) term.
